How to Wake a Sleeping Sola

When Do Solas Sleep?

This sometimes occurs when a Sola light hasn't been charged for an extended period of time or the battery has been run all the way down. Our engineers have designed to "hibernate" feature in order to conserve remaining battery life.

How to Wake a Sola Up:

Plug your charger into the wall and proceed to tap the charger's contacts rapidly against the light's charge contacts. After doing this for about five seconds, plug the charger all the way in. This surge of power can wake up the circuit, allowing the light to power back up and start taking a charge.

Be Patient

Finally, be aware that the Sola can sometimes take up to 6 seconds to start charging–if you haven't been leaving it on the charger long enough for the status LEDs to light up, it may just not have gotten started.

How to Avoid Sleeping Sola Syndrome

You can prevent this from happening by charging your Sola regularly, once every month or two.
